

Volt Edge Summary of VET Quality Framework audit information

A VET Quality Framework audit reviews evidence of an organisations' compliance with the requirements of the VET Quality Framework Essential Conditions and Standards of Initial/Continuing Registration to confirm that it is achieving quality training and assessment outcomes. The process also identifies opportunities for improvement on these outcomes. This information is published to assist apprentices, trainees and their employers to make informed decisions regarding their selection of a Pre-qualified Supplier for the delivery of training and assessment services.
